## First Catechism



- 116.** Q. What is the second petition?  
A. The second petition is “Thy kingdom come.”
- 117.** Q. What does it mean to pray, “Thy kingdom come.”?  
A. We are asking God to bring more and more people to hear, believe and obey his gospel.
- 118.** Q. What is the third petition?  
A. The third petition is “Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.”
- 119.** Q. What does it mean to pray, “Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven”?  
A. We are asking God to make us able and willing to serve him on earth just as he is served in heaven.
- 120.** Q. What is the fourth petition?  
A. The fourth petition is “Give us this day our daily bread.”
- 121.** Q. What does it mean to pray, “Give us this day our daily bread”?  
A. We are asking God to provide us with all that we really need.
- 122.** Q. What is the fifth petition?  
A. The fifth petition is “And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”

- 123.** Q. What does it mean to pray, “And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors”?  
A. We are asking God to forgive our sins for Christ’s sake, and to make us willing to forgive others.
- 124.** Q. What is the sixth petition?  
A. The sixth petition is “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”
- 125.** Q. What does it mean to pray, “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil”?  
A. We are asking God to keep us from being tempted and to make us strong enough to resist when we are tempted.
- 126.** Q. How many sacraments are there?  
A. Two
- 127.** Q. What are they?  
A. Baptism and the Lord’s Supper
- 128.** Q. Who appointed these sacraments?  
A. The Lord Jesus Christ.
- 129.** Q. Why did Christ appoint these sacraments?  
A. To distinguish his people from the world, and to comfort and strengthen them.

## God is Holy-

1. Isaiah 6:3

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty;  
the whole earth is full of his glory."

## God is Just-

2. Exodus 34: 6, 7

"The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished"

## God is Loving-

3. John 3:16

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

## Why is man separated from God and His love?

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"

### This sin has a penalty:

5. Romans 6:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

**God's Judgment upon sin is certain:**

6. Hebrews 9:27

"Man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment"

7. Isaiah 59:1,2

"Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor the ear too dull to hear. But your iniquities have separated you from God; your sins have hidden his face from you so that he will not hear."

**Man is in a terribly desperate situation, but**

**God has provided a solution...**

8. 1 Peter 3:18

"For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God."

**What is our response?**

9. John 5: 24

"I tell you the truth; whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life."

**If you:**

**R**ecognize your need for a Savior,

**R**epent of your sins and

**R**ecieve Jesus Christ into your life,

the Bible says.....

*you now have eternal life.*

10. 1 John 5:11-12
